SECOND ANNOUNCEMENT and CALL for PAPERS

The Mathematical Society of the Philippines (MSP) invites you to participate in its 2021 MSP Annual Convention to be held on 15, 22 and 29 May 2021 (Saturdays) via Zoom platform. The 2021 Convention marks the 48th year of MSP as the country's largest professional organization dedicated to the promotion of mathematics and mathematics education.

Researchers and educators in all areas of pure and applied mathematics, mathematics education, computing, statistics and other related areas are invited to contribute short papers for oral presentation during the convention. The convention will feature plenary talks and contributed talks as well as a session of invited talks by mathematics educators.

Plenary Speakers: Dr. Michael Dorff (Brigham Young University), Dr. Martianus Frederic Ezerman (Nanyang Technological University), Dr. Graeme Fairweather (Colorado School of Mines), Dr. Jomar Rabajante (University of the Philippines Los Baños), and Dr. Alejandro Velez-Santiago (University of Puerto Rico at Mayagüez)

Oral Presentations: Paper presentations will be organized in at least five parallel oral sessions (algebra, analysis, graph theory and combinatorics, computing, statistics, and applied mathematics). Those who wish to contribute oral presentations are requested to send their abstract (both in LaTeX/MSWord and pdf file) online via Google Form. Abstracts (100-250 words) should contain sufficient information about the paper to be properly evaluated by the scientific committee. The deadline for all abstracts is 15 March 2021. Notices of acceptance will be sent out by 15 April 2021. Authors of accepted papers will be instructed to pre-record 15-minute presentations and will submit the recorded presentations before May 15.
